LASSIES AND LADDIES II -OUTLINE ITINERARY

SUN, SEP 11- UNITED STATES TO EDINBURGH

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic.

MON, SEP 12- EDINBURGH ARRIVAL & FREE TIME

Your CIE Tours guide will meet you, welcome you to Scotland and assist in transferring to your hotel. The remainder of the day is free so that you can relax after the flight or do some independent sightseeing.

OVERNIGHT: RADISSON BLU HOTEL, EDINBURGH

TUE, SEP 13- EDINBURGH SIGHTSEEING

Set off on a guided tour of Scotland's capital city. Then take a guided tour of the imposing Edinburgh Castle, perched high above the city on volcanic rock. The balance of the afternoon is at leisure for individual pursuits. Tonight, join your group for dinner at a local pub or restaurant.

OVERNIGHT: RADISSON BLU HOTEL, EDINBURGH

WED, SEP 14- BLAIR ATHOL & CULLODEN VISITOR CENTRE

Depart Edinburgh and travel northwest to Pitlochry. Stop to visit the Blair Athol Distillery, where you can see the process of whisky production and sample the finished product at the end of the tour. Then enjoy some free time in Pitlochry before continuing to Culloden Moor to tour the Visitor Centre. Walk around the battlefield where, on April 16, 1746, Prince Charles Edward Stuart was defeated in just one hour. After your visit, drive into Inverness and check into your hotel. The evening free for independent dining.

OVERNIGHT: NEW DRUMOSSIE HOTEL, INVERNESS

THU, SEP 15- GLASGOW HIGHLIGHTS

Leaving Inverness, motor south through the Scottish countryside. Continue alongside the famous Loch Lomond, renowned for unsurpassed beauty of the lake and mountain Upon arrival to Glasgow enjoy a panoramic tour of the city. Then check into your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: HILTON HOTEL, GLASGOW

FRI, SEP 16- GLASGOW TO BELFAST

Leaving Glasgow, drive south through part of the Southern Uplands and along the coastline. At Cairnryan take a ferry ride across the narrow channel between Scotland and Ireland to Larne, just outside Belfast. Then drive a short distance to Belfast. Upon arrival check into your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: EUROPA HOTEL, BELFAST

SAT, SEP 17- BELFAST SIGHTSEEING & TITANIC BELFAST

Today embark on a sightseeing tour around the city. In the Titanic Quarter, visit the Titanic Belfast. Embark on a journey through the life of the Titanic, from her conception to the tragic end. After your visit enjoy the balance of the afternoon and evening at leisure for independent activities and dining. OVERNIGHT: EUROPA HOTEL, BELFAST

SUN, SEP 18- GIANT'S CAUSEWAY & DERRY WALKING TOUR

Depart Belfast and drive north to experience one of Ireland's popular scenic routes along the coast road. Here, you'll see the "Nine Glens of Antrim," which offer wonderful views of mountains, valleys and coastline. Stop to view the Giant's Causeway before continuing along the coast to Derry for a guided walking tour. Then check into your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: MALDRON HOTEL, DERRY

MON, SEP 19- SLIEVE LEAGUE CLIFFS & DONEGAL CASTLE

Leaving Derry, travel through Shalwy to reach the Slieve League cliffs, where the highest point reaches 1,972 feet making them the highest in Europe. Next enjoy tea and scones before driving to Donegal town. In the town center visit the ruins of Donegal Castle, which was built by the O'Donnell family. check into your hotel and settle into your room before dinner tonight.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: LOUGH ESKE CASTLE HOTEL, DONEGAL

TUE, SEP 20- BELLEEK CHINA & DRUMCLIFFE CHURCHYARD

This morning drive south to Belleek, where you'll visit the Belleek Pottery Factory. See how skilled craftspeople form and decorate clay to produce delicate porcelain masterpieces. From Belleek, travel a short distance to the coastal village of Mullaghmore. After a look around the village continue on to see the Creevykeel Court Tomb, which dates back to the Neolithic Period. Next head south to Drumcliffe Churchyard to see the grave of one of Ireland's most influential poets, W.B. Yeats. Then travel to Galway, where you will embark on a panoramic tour of the city before checking into your hotel. Once you settle into your room, enjoy a free evening. OVERNIGHT: MEYRICK HOTEL, GALWAY

WED. SEP 21- 'CONNEMARA LADY' CRUISE & CONNEMARA MARBLE

Today tour Connemara and admire the sweeping views of boglands and misty mountains. At Leenane, stop to take a short catamaran cruise aboard the "Connemara Lady" through Killary Harbour, Ireland's only fjord. Then drive a short distance to visit Kylemore Abbey an elegant mansion and church, set beside a tranquil lake. After your visit, continue your drive to the town of Moycullen to visit the Connemara Marble Factory. Quarried in Connemara, the soft green shades of the marble echoes the colors of the countryside from which it is cut. See how it is made into many decorative items. Head back to Galway, where the balance of the day is free.

OVERNIGHT: MEYRICK HÖTEL, GALWAY

THU, SEP 22- CLIFFS OF MOHER & KILLARNEY

Drive around Galway Bay and through the Burren Country, a unique region of limestone hills renowned for its flora and prehistoric stone monuments. Stop to view the majestic Cliffs of Moher before taking a short ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary to the mountainous countryside of Kerry. Arrive in Killarney and check into your hotel. Then you will have the afternoon free to relax or stroll around town before dinner.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: KILLARNEY PLAZA HOTEL, KILLARNEY

FRI, SEP 23- DINGLE PENINSULA TOUR

After breakfast discover the beauties of the Dingle Peninsula, made famous by David Lean's movie, "Ryan's Daughter." Drive along the south shore of the peninsula to see heathery mountains, sandy stretches of beach and rocky headlands. There will be frequent stops at strategic locations to admire the views and take photos. Continue your drive on to the western tip of the peninsula. Stop at the South Pole Inn for Irish coffee with group before returning to Killarney for a free evening.

OVERNIGHT: KILLARNEY PLAZA HOTEL, KILLARNEY

SAT, SEP 24- BLARNEY CASTLE & DUBLIN

Leaving Killarney, drive to Blarney, where you may climb to the battlements of Blarney Castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Also visit the Blarney Woollen Mills, which has an excellent range of Irish products. Then depart Blarney and drive north towards Dublin. Pass through many marketing towns, each with its own characteristics. Arrive in Dublin, and check into your hotel. Then use your Hop on Hop off pass to visit a number of places. There are plenty of museums, shops and pubs you may wish to visit. You can also use you voucher to visit either the Jameson Distillery or the Guinness Storehouse. In the evening, enjoy dinner at the hotel.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CAMDEN COURT HOTEL, DUBLIN SUN, SEP 25- RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES
